- 5. Your abstract should only be one page long and should not contain any other header or footer.
- 6. If you want to add figures and/or references go ahead but make sure that the abstract is not more than one page.
- 7. Abstracts more than one page will not be accepted.
- 8. Please do not add page number, the software to create the Book of Abstracts will add page numbers.
- 9. You can either submit the .tex file or convert it to pdf and submit the pdf file.
- 10. Upload your abstract at http://www.hpc.lsu.edu/users/symposium/index.php (preferred) or email it to lsuhpchelp@gmail.com with the email subject Poster Abstract for HPC User Symposium.
- 11. The pdf file should be renamed as LastName_FirstName-Abstract.pdf for example Doe_John-Abstract.pdf.
- 12. If you want to be considered for a 15-30 min talk, make sure that you select the correct option in your registration form.
- 13. If your LastName and FirstName is not unique (rare case), you will not be able to upload your abstract. Please add a number to your abstract so that it will be uploaded.
- 14. Please do not email us the pdf/ppt of your poster. You will need to bring your poster with you on June 12th. Poster Board size is 4ftx4ft.
